# FAQs and How-To's

### Q. How do I get International Services added to my account?

A. It's easy. If you do not already have International Services, just contact your sales representative or call **1-866-MOBILITY**, and say you are interested in activating International Services on your account. Or, if you have Internet access, go to **att.com**. Set up or log in to your myatt account. Go to "Manage Features." Scroll down to International Features and select those you wish to add to your line of service.

Certain restrictions apply.

# Q. How do I make an international long distance call from the U.S.?

A. Enter "+" (or 011) followed by the country code and local number you wish to call.

**Important Note:** When calling or sending text messages to certain countries such as Canada, Jamaica and many other Caribbean locations, an international dialing feature is not required. Simply dial "1" plus the local number of the recipient.

# Q: Where do I find country codes and rates for dialing internationally from the U.S.?

A. For a complete list, please visit att.com/global.

# Q. How do I dial a "local" number while roaming internationally?

A. In most countries, dial the local number just as you would from a wireline phone in that country.

# Q. How do I place a call or send a text, picture or video message back to the U.S.?

A. Enter "+" then "1" followed by the area code and the number you are contacting. With most GSM™ devices, the "+" sign will appear if you press and hold the "0" key.

# Q. How do I contact International Customer Service while traveling abroad?

A. When traveling outside the U.S., call +1-916-843-4685 24 hours a day/7 days a week (a free call from your wireless phone).

# Q. How am I charged for calls made and received while traveling abroad?

A. You will incur a flat, per-minute, roaming airtime charge for calls placed and received while traveling abroad. Additional charges may apply for emergency or directory assistance calls.

# Q. How do I check voicemail messages while roaming abroad?

- A. 1. Press and hold the voicemail retrieval key on your phone (this is typically the "1" key).
  - 2. Interrupt your personal greeting by pressing the "\*" key and enter your voicemail password.†

**Important Note:** In some cases, you may reach the main voicemail system greeting. If so, just enter your 10-digit wireless number, and then follow step 2.

† You can reset your password by calling Customer Care at 611 or 1-800-331-0500 (in U.S.) or +1-916-843-4685 (outside U.S.) or at att.com/myatt.

International roaming charges will apply.

# Q. Do I need a special phone when traveling to Japan or South Korea?

A. Yes, you'll need a phone that operates on 3G technology at 2100 MHz to roam in Japan and South Korea. AT&T sells multiple phones for worldwide travel, including devices that work in Japan and South Korea.

### Q. Can I use my wireless phone while on a cruise?

A. Yes. AT&T offers wireless voice, messaging and data service on more than 250 major cruise ships. The cruise ship voice rate of \$2.49/minute applies. Pay-per-use rates apply for messaging or data usage while on board. For details, check att.com/global.

# Q. Can I send text messages and access data services while traveling abroad?

A. Text messaging is typically available in all countries in which AT&T has international voice roaming service (more than 225 countries). Picture/video messaging and GPRS data services are available in more than 210 countries. High-speed 3G data service is available in more than 165 of those countries. For details, check att.com/global.

### Q. How am I charged for data usage outside the U.S.?

A. International roaming rates apply for any voice or data usage outside our domestic coverage area. International data usage is not included as part of your domestic data plan. We suggest signing up for one of AT&T's Data Global Add-On Packages that can save you money on your international data usage. For details, please visit att.com/worldpackages.

# Q. What steps should I take if my data services are not registering upon my arrival abroad?

- A. If you are having difficulty using data services outside the U.S., try these trouble-shooting steps:
  - 1. For smartphones: Remove battery and reinsert.
  - Try manual scanning (not available in Canada or Mexico): Settings > Options > Network > Change network selection to manual > Click scan for new network. From the list of networks that appears, select a network other than the one on which you are currently registered.
  - 3. For PC cards: Remove card; reboot computer; reinsert card.

# Q. How can I keep my data charges predictable when I use my device outside the U.S.?

- A. Here are some easy ways to help you manage international data charges when you travel abroad
  - Purchase a Data Global Add-On Package. Visit att.com/worldpackages for details.
  - 2. Track your usage upon arrival abroad. If your device doesn't offer an embedded usage tracker, you can use the myAT&T app or download a third-party data-tracking app.
  - 3. If you don't want to receive email automatically, disable your device's auto-check functionality. You can then utilize Wi-Fi® to manually check email.

### Making calls and sending messages while outside the U.S.

Tip: With most GSM phones, the "+" key will appear on your screen if you press and hold down the "0" key.



# Making calls and sending messages from the U.S.

- Calls to another country:
   Dial "+" (or 011) (country code) (local number)
- Calls to Canada and many Caribbean locations: Dial "1" (area code) (local number)



### Checking voicemail while outside the U.S.

- 1. Press and hold the voicemail retrieval key on your phone (typically the "1" key).
- 2. Interrupt your personal greeting by pressing "\*".
- 3. Enter your voicemail password.

Note: In some cases, you may reach the main voicemail system greeting. Just enter your 10-digit wireless number and then follow steps 2 and 3. International roaming charges will apply.



#### Accessing an international network

- Before traveling, an International Roaming feature must be activated on your account.
- If you experience service issues, turn your phone off for one minute, then back on.
- Be sure your phone's frequency band is set to "automatic."
- If you are not receiving email, detach your smartphone battery and then reinsert it.
- If your PC card is not registering, remove the card; reboot computer; reinsert PC card.
