PLUS What Worked Well

- Building rosters were easily accessible, well-organized and had clear instructions
- Drill was faster than last year
- Managers and co-workers were able to provide status on location of staff members
- Fire extinguishers were removed from the buildings through the evacuation

DELTA Areas for Improvement

- Must keep building rosters up to date, and should include temporary staff on building rosters
- Should have pre-meeting with all EAP coordinators, and have back-ups
- Need to update the location of the EAP for Pine Hall
- Should hold the next drill in the afternoon, when there are more staff present


PLUS What Worked Well

- Seamless integration of non-IT, off campus and corporate volunteers
- Addition of the 2nd story extrication, preceded by months of practice and validated by PAFD
- Inclusion of live victims
- Reaching San Jose via Ham Radio
- Two excellent photographers capturing images from the drill
- Recognition by DPS and external participants of organization and teamwork of volunteers

DELTA Areas for Improvement

- Heavy radio traffic, must expand to more channels
- Must slow down, speak more concisely, and summarize in radio communication
- Must clarify and reinforce call signs
- Streamline briefing and check-in process
- Should separate triage from treatment
- Evaluate use of a T-Card System for personnel accountability
- ARK closure took longer due to needing to refill the water barrels
