We're writing because our records show you use an Android device for Stanford work.

As part of the School of Medicine's [transition to the new Microsoft login](#), university Microsoft apps like Outlook, Teams, and OneDrive will no longer work on the personal side of your Android Work Profile after conditional access is enabled.

Do you need to take action?

- If you have university Outlook or other Microsoft apps installed in your Android personal profile, you'll need to move your Stanford account to your Work Profile before the July 20, 2026, deadline.
- If you don't have Stanford Outlook or other Microsoft apps installed in your Android personal profile, no action is needed.

What you need to do

- Follow our [step-by-step guide](#) to move your Stanford Microsoft account to your Android Work Profile.
- This takes just a few minutes but must be completed before July 20 to ensure uninterrupted access to your university email and other Microsoft services.
